Over the years we have:

- Maintained Free Parking areas in the Park for Paddlewheel Park, Hall & NOSA Patrons
- Mandated area allotments to accommodate both the Boat Launch and a safe swimming area for families
- Mandated the landscaping in and around the Park
- Created a lease agreement with the Regional District of the North Okanagan to provide security and maintenance of the Park as well as relief from taxes without relinquishing control of Paddlewheel Park and its facilities
- Renovated and restored the original 1892 Stationhouse to accommodate a Museum and Art Gallery
- Managed and maintained the Community Hall to facilitate Community Activities
- Created opportunities for the Landing Community to come together and share common interests
